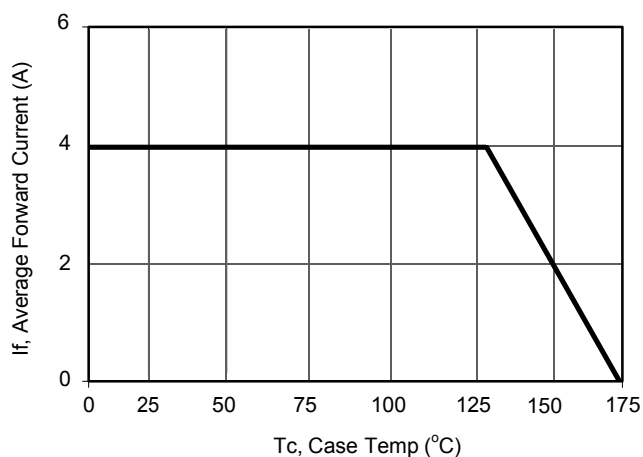

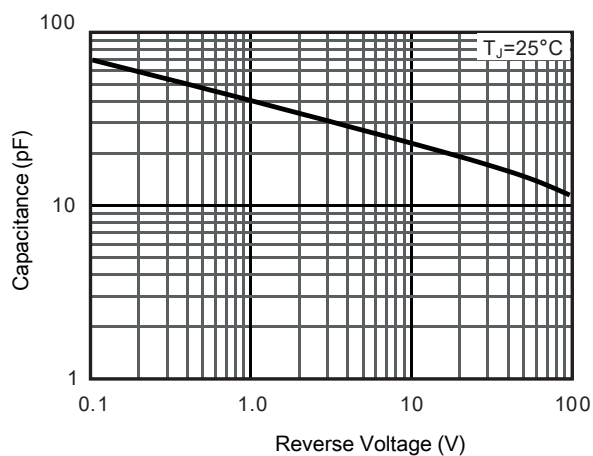

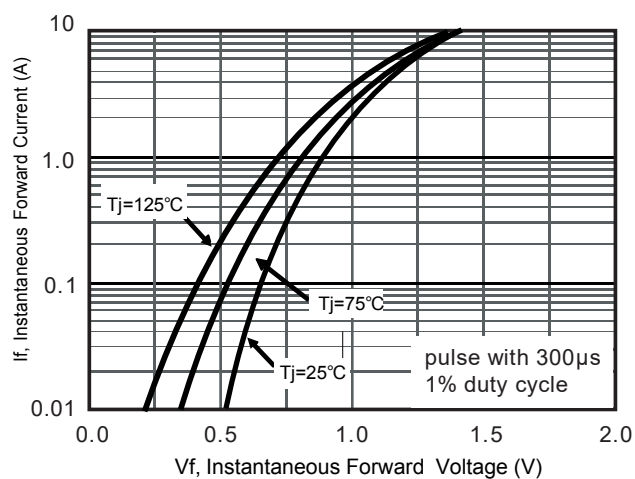
RATINGS AND CHARACTERISTICS CURVES ($T_A = 25^\circ\text{C}$ unless otherwise noted)



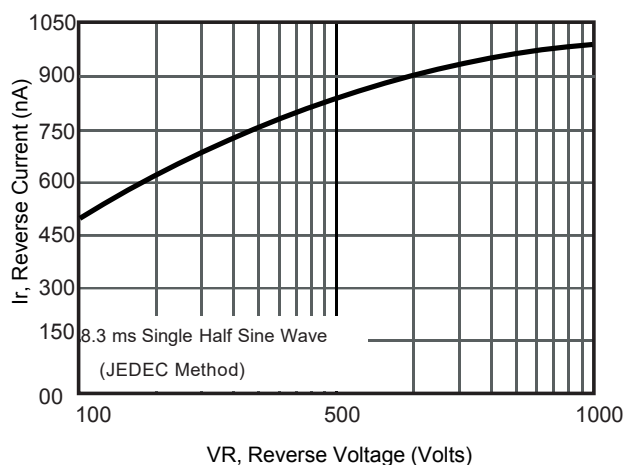
Current Derating, Case



Typical Junction Capacitance



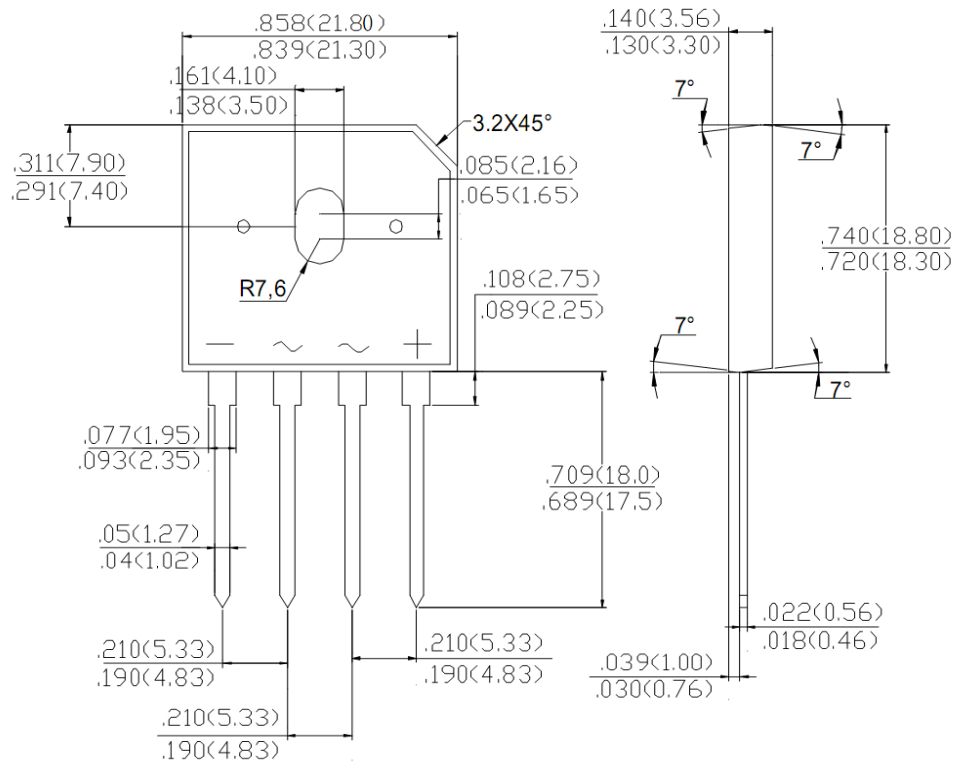
Typical Forward Voltage
